

Rules of the Tournament

- A \$225 non refundable registration fee, team roster, and a signed waiver form for each player must be received by 8/1/10. If forms are not received by 8/1, team will not be included in tournament schedule.
- All forms available at www.serafinitournament.org.
- A maximum of 24 teams will participate. Teams accepted on first come, first serve basis.
- No alcoholic beverages permitted on park grounds.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated from players, coaches or spectators. Those that do not cooperate will be escorted from park premises.
- ASA rules for coed slow pitch softball rules apply.
- A copy of co-ed rules specific to this tournament will be provided to each team captain and posted at each field.
- Captains are responsible for ensuring that each player knows and accepts the rules.
- 50% of players on the field must be female.
- All players must be at least 16 years of age.
- Each player begins with a one ball/one strike count.
- 12 – inch balls with a Ball COR of .440 and a Ball Compression of 375.0 lbs. will be used for male batters and 11-inch balls with Ball COR of .44 & ball compression of 375 will be used for female batters.
- No titanium bats are permitted.
- A one hour time limit per game is imposed
- Each team is responsible for keeping score. Scorebooks will be provided.
- \$1 passes to the Municipal Pool will be available at the concession stand for participants and families.
